



Idea: Vouchers for participation in exhibitions

Idea description

Title:	Vouchers for participation in exhibitions
Idea objective	Participation in exhibitions is one of the essential business tools for expanding the market for the sale of goods and services. However, participation in such exhibitions, especially those held abroad, requires high costs. A small business needs more resources to carry out such expenses and is therefore forced to operate mainly in local markets. This activity's main idea is to support local small businesses participation in national and international exhibitions.
Sharing process (max 1000 characters)	 Implementation of the measure will require the public institution to carry out the following activities: 1. to discuss with small businesses and public institutions which vouchers are the most necessary for local companies to enter other markets. 2. to agree on the types of vouchers and conditions of provision. It is appropriate to allocate vouchers to a single firm and a group of firms (cluster). The provision's requirements may provide for advance payment or only payment on the principle of reimbursement of expenses. 3. conduct an information campaign among small businesses regarding the possibility of obtaining Vouchers for participation in exhibitions 4. evaluate applications and provide small businesses with Vouchers for participation in exhibitions 5. to evaluate the results of actions on the provision of Vouchers for participation in exhibitions
Restrictions/rules (law, skills, time, other)	The effectiveness of this action depends on the number of resources the city can attract for its implementation.
Procedures (if applicable)	Experts are also needed to recommend which areas of economic activity it is expedient to support business participation in exhibitions.
Costs for public institutions (if applicable)	The city should develop and approve formal procedures for providing Vouchers for exhibition participation.
Expected result (if possible)	The city should allocate its funds for this activity and try to find resources for this from national and international programs available in this country.
