

## Idea: Joint grant programs for youth on Social Business

### Idea description

<b>Title:</b>	Joint grant programs (projects) (local public authorities & NGOs) for youth on Social Business
<b>Idea objective</b>	<p>The main objective of this activity is to find organizational and financial resources for joint activities of local public authorities &amp; NGOs to support youth social entrepreneurship.</p> <p>This goal can be achieved through two main tasks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- development of a local grant program</li> <li>- receiving funding from donors in the form of a project that will involve regrating or other forms of support at the local level.</li> </ul>
<b>Sharing process (max 1000 characters)</b>	<p>This activity can be implemented in different ways. We recommend paying attention to the most typical steps:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Creation of a coordinating group for program (project) development</li> <li>2. Development of procedures for providing support to young people for conducting social business</li> <li>3. Conducting a promotional campaign to attract young people to contests to support social business</li> <li>4. Evaluation of the results of youth applications and control and assistance in the implementation of youth plans</li> <li>5. Monitoring results and improvement of procedures for supporting youth social entrepreneurship.</li> </ol>
<b>Restrictions/rules (law, skills, time, other)</b>	<p>Implementing this action requires the joint activity of local public authorities &amp; NGOs. It is necessary to attract people with experience in implementing projects and programs. Very often, employees of local public authorities in small towns do not have the proper qualifications to implement such programs.</p>
<b>Procedures (if applicable)</b>	<p>The preparation of programs and projects should be an open process. And the implementation and execution process must have approved procedures.</p>
<b>Costs for public institutions (if applicable)</b>	<p>The city must allocate its own funds for such programs. It is also necessary to have funds for one's own contribution in most cases to attract funds from donors funds.</p>
<b>Expected result (if possible)</b>	<p>Involvement of young people in business. Improvement of the economic and social situation in the city</p>
