



Idea: Access to the database with the partners of the local public authority

Idea description

Title:	Access to the database with the partners of the local public authority (who can also become partners of the small business or intermediaries for contacting new partners)
Idea objective	This activity is aimed at encouraging local small business to develop new partnerships both with national and foreign partners. Sharing contacts from the local public authorities' databases with small business is a good opportunity for both parts to establish relations and possible consortiums. The access to the database may be temporary – a defined period of time, for a one-use only (sharing a concrete contact) or for a long period. Indifferent of the sharing-model a cooperation framework is needed between local public authority and private partner.
Sharing process (max 1000 characters)	 The implementation of actions requires the following steps: Existing an updated and functional database of contacts/partners at the level of the public authority (that would allow fast and efficient work incl. searching by keywords etc.) Responsible person for partnerships/relations that operates with the database within the local public authority Direct contact and good cooperation between local public authority and mSME Establishing the cooperation framework between the local public authority and the mSME (signing an agreement, a special contract if needed etc.) and defining the period of resource sharing, technical aspects of using the database Specification the fields/spheres of needed contacts Common action plan if needed, how the contact will be valued by the mSME and which is the role of the local public authority (facilitator, partner, intermediary, etc.) Follow-up of the contacts sharing through dialogue between local public authority and small business
Restrictions/rules (law, skills, time, other)	This activity may have following restrictions: 1. Limited access and sharing possibilities of specific contacts / partners of the local public authorities 2. Lack of internal capacities within the local public authorities in terms of database, limited human capacities to exploit partnerships and contacts
Procedures (if applicable)	This idea does not require the implementation of specific administrative procedures. However, a GDPR policy would be needed in case of personal data sharing through database.

Expected result (if possible)	Establishing new partnerships by local mSMEs by sharing contacts from LPAs side
