Idea description

Title:	The organisation of discussions with the local businesses of the public procurement plan of local authorities and public institutions
Idea objective	<p>Local business is an essential part of local communities, and quite often, business representatives participate in the discussion of local community development plans. However, local authorities and public institutions usually do not discuss procurement plans for goods and services. At best, these institutions publish such procurement plans on their web resources. These processes are regulated by public procurement legislation, which local authorities and public institutions must follow.</p> <p>The main idea of the proposed action is to organise a preliminary discussion of procurement plans for those goods and services that local SMEs can provide.</p> <p>Such a discussion should comply with the principles of transparency and fair competition, which are in force in the EU.</p>
Sharing process (max 1000 characters)	<p>Implementation of the measure will require the public institution to carry out the following activities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. the city government should survey public institutions located on the territory of the city regarding the readiness to present procurement plans for general discussion, 2. to analyse the typical conditions of public procurement carried out by public institutions in the city (what are the needs for goods and services and what can be provided by local businesses), 3. prepare proposals for making changes to procurement processes so that local businesses have certain preferences within the framework of current legislation, 4. organise a series of consultations with local businesses and public institutions, for example, on the types of goods and services needed, 5. coordinate new procurement procedures with public institutions in the city and disseminate information among local businesses.
Restrictions/rules (law, skills, time, other)	Legislation on public procurement. It is necessary to have experts analyse procurement conditions and prepare proposals for businesses and public institutions.
Procedures (if applicable)	Each public institution must approve new public procurement procedures.
Costs for public institutions (if applicable)	This action requires the working time of employees of public institutions and the remuneration of the involved experts.
Expected result (if possible)	Development of local business, increase of taxes to the local budget, improvement of service for public institutions in the field of procurement of goods and services
